Overall attendance this half-term is **92.90%**, well below our **96%** target. 54 children achieved 100% attendance this half term, a big well done to them and to their parents! * This is a huge achievement, thank you for your ongoing support.

However, absence due to illness and extended leave remain an ongoing issue again this half term. There is a strong correlation between good attendance and positive learning outcomes.
